



STATE HOUSE

1. Head to main entrance of the State House at 100 State Circle, Annapolis MD 21401.
(#1 on the map on the following page)
2. Use the visitors entrance to the right of State House front steps; this entrance is at sidewalk level and has an arch.
3. Pass through the Capitol Police security screening inside the entrance.
4. After exiting the screening, proceed straight to the second desk on the right — the State House Information Desk *(to the right of the shoeshine stand)*.

Downtown Parking

- 1 Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium**
 - Daily flat fee. Public parking lot entrance: Gate #5, Taylor Ave. The State Shuttle runs to Annapolis Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at 20 minute intervals. Saturday and Sunday service, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. No service on State holidays unless the General Assembly is in session. Parking is \$10 and shuttle service costs \$2 per ride.
- 2 Park Place Garage**
 - Hourly rate – entrance on Taylor Ave.
 - Public Restroom
- 3 Knighton Garage**
 - Hourly rate – entrance on Colonial Ave.
 - Public Restroom
- 4 Whitmore Garage**
 - Hourly rate – entrance on Clay St.
- 5 Larkin Lot**
 - Hourly rate public parking on evenings – entrance on City Gate Ln.
- 6 Gotts Court Garage**
 - Hourly rate – entrances on Calvert St. and Northwest St.
 - Public Restroom
- 7 Calvert Street Garage**
 - State employee parking by permit only during working hours (6 a.m. - 7 p.m. Monday*, 6 a.m. - 6 p.m. Tuesday - Friday). Free public parking 6 p.m. - 6 a.m. on weekdays, and all day Saturday and Sunday – entrance on St. John's St.
- 8 South St. Lot**
 - Hourly rate – entrance on South St.
- 9 Noah Hillman Garage**
 - Hourly rate – entrances on Duke of Gloucester St. and Gorman St.
 - Public Restroom
- 10 Donner Parking Lot**
 - Metered parking – entrance on Compromise St.
- 11 Fleet Parking Lot**
 - Metered parking – entrance on Compromise St.
- 12 City Dock Lot**
 - Metered parking – entrance on Dock St.
 - Public Restroom

* Only during the Legislative Session (Jan. - April). Be aware parking may be limited during Session. Please check the Session schedule at mgaleg.maryland.gov.
