

Jeaneanne Gettle is the current Deputy Regional Administrator (DRA) for the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in Region 4. In this capacity she works closely with eight state and six tribal governments to protect human health and the environment across the southeast. She has been with the EPA for over 36 years and brings strong leadership and management skills to the position. Prior to taking on the DRA responsibilities, she served as the Director of the Water Division. Jeaneanne also served as the Director of EPA Region 4's Science and Ecosystem Support Division in Athens, GA. In addition, she has held positions as the Acting Director of the Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) Division in the Office of Chemical, Safety and Pollution Prevention in EPA Headquarters in Washington, DC and in the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division in Region 4. Jeaneanne served in a variety of roles throughout Region 4 implementing environmental programs including Superfund, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), Pesticides and Toxics, and what is now the Mission Support Division. She has been recognized for her achievements with awards that include a Gold Medal, Silver Medal, numerous Bronze Medals for programmatic work, and EPA's National Honor Award for Managerial Leadership.
